



## GENERAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFERS

If you've earned credit or an associate degree from any community college in the U.S., you'll be able to **transfer up to 60 credits** to Northeastern's College of Professional Studies. Like all CPS applicants, you'll also be **eligible for a range of scholarship opportunities**.

### PARTNER COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFERS





Collect your application materials. We'll need to see an official high school transcript, GED score, or <u>attestation form</u>; official transcripts for **ANY community college or four-year school you've attended**; and any other documentation necessary for transfer credit.

Please submit all previous transcripts or written confirmation that you do not want to transfer credits from one or more of your previous institutions to ensure that your transfer credit request can be processed.
